This left people confused, including his Guru, Tegh Bahadur. Despite this, he also believed in God, which is why he was not convinced. He returned to his Guru and asked him what he should believe in. He then said: God is One, but the Guru told him he is all powerful. On the other hand, it was said that many people would testify that Guru Gobind Singh was possessed by a japa (pious recitation of Gurbani) demon. This demon is commonly believed to be a reason why he left his Guru after being ordained. Yet, the Sikh community still upholds his teachings. This can be seen from their reverence of his name - Guru Amar Das Ji - that literally means "His Guru" or "His God". This is quite ironic since Gurbani is mostly chanted, and is recited in his name. The Ghaznavi or Tumandar was a warrior who fought against the invading hordes of Shah-Parvez and the Ghurids, who were Muslim invaders. The Ghaznavid rulers and the Khilji dynasty were responsible for developing the Persian language and script into what is now known as the Shahada or Islamic personal statement. They spoke Persian and worshipped Hindu gods, but kept their religion secret from the non-Muslim masses. They went as far as speaking to Hindu priests to establish themselves as far more educated than the non-Muslim, and this way remained loyal to the Hindu God. This tradition carried on in the kingdoms of the Mughals, the Marathas, and the British Indian Empire.
